- 11) If one has a cluster of grapes with some spoiled ones, how does one take those grapes that one wants?
- 12) If one has mixed nuts and one wants a certain type, what should one do?
- 13) If one has a pile of mixed cutlery, may one set the table before davening?
- 14) How does one define B'yad-by hand?
- 15) When is one permitted to use a fork, spoon or knife?
- 16) Is one permitted to use an apple corer?
- 17) Is one permitted to use a slotted spoon?
- 18) Is one permitted to use a vegetable peeler on Shabbos?
- 19) If one has a tea bag in liquid, can one remove the tea bag?

- 55) Is there any problem for me to clear the table because of borer?
- 56) If one has a bowl with mixed fruit, is there any way to separate them in order to put them away?
- 57) After the meal can one stack the dishes in a dishwasher?
- 58) If one has a case of different flavored sodas and I want a certain flavor, is there a problem of borer to take the flavor that I want?
- 59) Is there a problem of borer by taking items out of the fridge or freezer?
- 60) Is one permitted to take out a cake from the freezer in order for it to defrost due to borer?
- 61) If one would want to know if there a mixture, how can one define if it is two items or one?
- 62) If one has two of the same style skirts but in different sizes, is it considered as two different items or the same item?
- 63) If one has large toys mixed together is there a problem of borer to separate them?
- 64) If one has an apple with a small amount spoiled area, what should one do in order to remove the spoiled area?

- 66) Is there a problem of borer to take sefarim out of a bookcase?

- 68) Is one permitted to use a pot cover to pour the soup which I want and hold back the bones and vegetables?

- 70) Is one permitted to prepare a fruit platter for it to be ready for one's children to eat in the park?
- 71) Is one permitted to prepare children's clothing Friday night in order for the children to get dressed Shabbos morning?
- 72) Is one permitted to select all the Siddurim from a mixture of sefarim after Shacharis and put them back into the bookcase in order for them to be available for Mincha?
