It is critical that the Shel Rosh be placed properly. The proper location is with the lower part <u>not below</u> the line where the hair begins to (or used to) grow.

## If they are lower than that, one does not fulfill the mitzvah of tefilin





The reverse of this card contains instructions for adjusting the size of the Shel Rosh. If you are hesitant to adjust them yourself, ask a sofer or other expert to help, but be sure that the size is right for correct placement.

Say: לשם קדושת תפלין, then

- 1. Pull the strap marked with the arrow down, making the head-loop smaller.
- 2. Close the loop you just made under the knot by pulling up from behind (direction of arrow)
- Close the second loop, made in step 2, by pulling down on the free-hanging part of the strap.
- Kesher is complete.
