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Do you rely on the word of the salesmen?



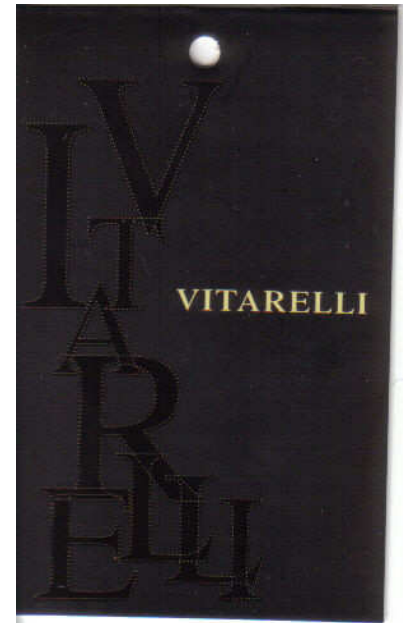
A) A *choson* purchased a suit from a Jewish-owned store in Boro Park. The storeowner guaranteed that the suit had no shatnez. The *choson* wore the suit to his *vort* without testing it. Before the *chasunah* he decided to check it and, to his horror, it had a linen collar!

The only label in the suit was the one shown to the left.

B) **Vitarelli** wool men's suits sold at a recent suit sale in Lakewood contained shatnez. They had linen in their inner components.

Some of the Vitarelli men's suits had linen shell fabrics as well as wool inner components. This type of shatnez is quite expensive to remove and repair.
