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Do Chinese Suits Contain Shatnez?

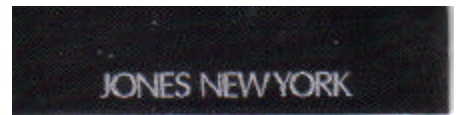


A] A **Calvin Klein** (China) men's suit with a content label listing 55% Wool, 45% Silk was found to be mislabeled.

The true contents were Wool, Linen & Silk – Shatnez!
The picture shows an actual swatch of the Shatnez fabric.

Found by the Deal Shatnez Laboratory

B] These brand name men's suit labels were, up until now, usually found to be shatnez –free.



They are now being manufactured with linen, collar interlinings in China.

A Professional Shatnez Laboratory should inspect these brands because the linen is processed and easily missed.
