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## Shatnez in Scarves

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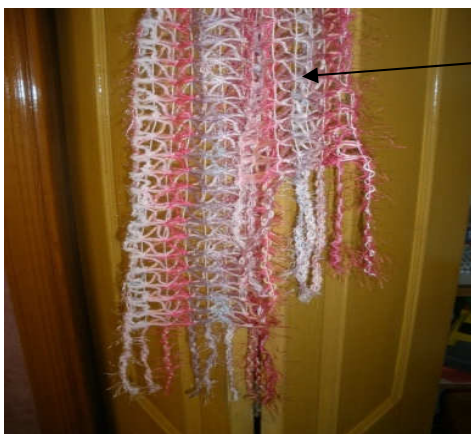
Shatnez in the actual fabric of scarves is not common. However, when a scarf is made from a more complex woven fabric, it could have shatnez. Here are two examples.



A] This plaid scarf had no labels attached.

It was composed of recycled threads and contained both wool and linen.

B] This scarf contained both linen blend and wool blend threads. The scarf had no contents label attached as well.

Found by: The Lakewood Shatnez Laboratory.
