

## TISHREI 5772 Consumer Notice

This public notice describes the types of garments recommended for Shatnez testing.

## **Recommended For Testing:**

- 1) All garments (including hats and caps) listing either wool or linen on their content labels.
- 2) All jackets\*.
- 3) Any garment whose fabric consists of.....
  - a) threads of various thicknesses\*, or
  - b) both shiny and dull threads\*.

\* even if wool or linen is not listed on its content label.

## **Other Information**

- The list above applies to men's, women's, and children's clothing equally.
- Garments should be tested at a professional Shatnez laboratory for accurate results. A list of professional laboratories under the Hashgacha of Vaad L'mishmeres Shatnez is available upon request.
- The Shatnez status of garments cannot be based simply on the country of origin. Claims by individuals, such as clothing manufacturers and salespersons, regarding a garment's Shatnez status, can only be verified by a knowledgeable Shatnez expert.
- Proper Shatnez removal requires extensive specialized training. If Shatnez was removed by an untrained person *(including a tailor)*, a Shatnez expert must examine the garment *before* it is worn.
